Course requirements

Summary

You will be participating in your Transition Camp session with the other students in the program. You will complete all advance assignments, and all lessons assigned during the session. You will write a short journal and evaluation, to be completed within two weeks of the end of the session.

- 1 Complete the advance assignments, including the extra credit assignments. (Web site: www.serrc.org/academy)
- 2 Work with your fellow students and your teacher as you prepare for the school and community presentation.
- 3 Attend and participate in all the student activities for the session.
- 4 Complete a journal/evaluation of the Transition Camp session, and mail or FAX it to the instructor within two weeks of the end of your session.

Transition Camp Journal contents:

- a. Describe the effectiveness of the Transition Camp web site and assignments in preparing you for your Transition Camp experience.
- b. For each day, Sunday through Friday, write up to two or three paragraphs that discuss one or more of the following:
 - Major concepts you learned about transitioning from school to adult life.
 - The learning activities that taught you the most about yourself.
 - General evaluation of positive aspects of the day and any suggestions for improving the experience.
- c. Discuss how your overall Transition Camp experience has influenced your plans for further education or training.
